Thorney Hill, Bransgore;
Christchurch Priory and the
Red House Museum
Tuesday 15th May 2018

The visit starts with a guided tour of All Saints Church, built in 1906 by Detmar Blow and containing a mural by Phoebe Traquair and memorials by Sir Bertram MacKenna with lettering by Eric Gill. We then have coffee followed by a guided tour of Christchurch Priory, its crypt and museum. After a stroll in the grounds of Christchurch Castle, we will have lunch at the Kings Arms Hotel followed by a guided tour of the Red House Museum, a former Georgian workhouse.

Travel by car—arrive by 10am. Those travelling by train can omit the church and arrive for the Priory at 11am. The cost is £45 per person including coffee and two course set lunch, or £30 for those who prefer to organise their own lunch.
