

Visit to St. Michael's Abbey and Air Sciences Museum at Farnborough

A visit has been arranged for **Thursday, 24th April 2014.**

At the Abbey we will see the mausoleum built by the Empress Eugenie of France for the remains of her husband, the former Napoleon III.

The Air Sciences Museum provides a great contrast, where we will gain a wide picture of the important scientific work of the Royal Aircraft Establishment from before 1914 up to its recent closure. We will see a replica of the first machine to fly there.

The visit will last from **10 a.m. until about 3.30 p.m.**, and the cost is £25 to **include refreshments on arrival and a sandwich lunch.**
